Lone Twin are back on tour with a raucous reimagining of True West, Sam Shepard's classic 1970s study of the creative act.

Shepard's original play is set in a kitchen, in a house, in a suburb, some 40 miles out of Los Angeles. It is the story of two brothers, locked in conflict, with competing stories to tell and sell.

Since Gregg Whelan and Gary Winters formed Lone Twin in 1997, the multi-purpose company has earned critical acclaim across the world.

Recent productions include The Boat Project for the London 2012 Cultural Olympiad and Street Dance for Sadler's Wells and the Sydney Festival.

Into their complete reworking of True West, Whelan and Winters introduce a rowdy chorus assembled for one night only from each host venue. Hold on to your hats, it's going to be quite a night.
