YAYA WEAVE workshop is an attempt to bring people together to create community and comfort. Through weaving fabric, we are also examining- in an informal and experimental way- the weaving of stories and relationships.

It is an effort 'to keep things together and make things whole' (Louise Bourgeois) particularly in contemplating the complexities of difference and displacement within communities.

By slowing down the mind, the hands can show us ways to connect and allow forgotten stories to emerge. Come to enjoy colours and patterns, meditation, reflection, find rhythm and words, find common ground, bring together disparate bits of fabric, thread or ancestral story.
